

Directions:

We will try to leave no later than 8am from the Chapel Hill area so to get Cass by 4pm.
We will stop at C&O railroad museum at Clifton Forge, VA and have lunch in Clifton Forge.

Directions to Clifton Forge, VA (C&O Railroad Museum)

It is located at 705 Main Street, Clifton Forge, VA 24422 www.candoheritage.org

From Chapel Hill to Clifton Forge, 4 hours and 190 miles going through

Roanoke, 3 hours and 145 miles

> Take I-85 west to Efland, Exit 160,

> turn right, cross RR tracks and then left, cross US 70 at traffic light

Continue on Cedar Grove Road to NC 86, (this will bypass Hillsborough),

> turn left on NC 86 (N) to Danville, VA

> south of Danville, turn left on US 29 west to US 58 toward Martinsville,

> take US 58 bypass around Martinsville to US 220

> take US 220 to Roanoke VA

There is gasoline at the north end of the Martinsville bypass on US 220.

From Roanoke to Clifton Forge, 1 hour, 45 miles

> At Roanoke, take I-581 north to I-81 north to US 220, exit 150B north to Clifton Forge.

(I have found this is the best route.) Watch your speed on I-581.

> As you approach Clifton Forge, you can take either Business US 220 or US 60 west into town.

I usually take business US 220, cross over the railroad and turn left onto Main Street

> the C&O museum is on your left before reaching center of town.

To White Sulphur Springs, WV (30 miles) and then Cass:

> From Museum, turn left on Main Street to Ridgeway Street to reach I-64 west

> take I-64 west to WV exit 181 at White Sulphur Springs, WV

> purchase gasoline at the station on right at intersections of US 60 and WV 92

====Last gasoline available until Greenbank

>>> Also Cell Service ends 2 miles north White Sulphur Springs

Cass and Boyer (where we are staying) 1 hour and 30 min, 65 miles

> at White Sulphur Springs take WV 92N to Boyer –.

> Boyer to Cass - 30 minutes south WV 92 to WV 66 west

From Chapel Hill to Cass are about 6 hours and 275 miles

From Wilmington to Cass are about 8 hours and 425 miles
